COMMUNICATION FRIENDLY CLASSROOM CHECKLIST



- Background noise is minimised
- Reduce any visual distractions i.e., information on display boards
- There's a use of visuals in the environment
- Visual timetables are used throughout the day
- Adults adapt their language to support pupils' understanding
- Actions/Signs and images are used to represent keywords being taught
- Rules & Expectations are embedded across the school day
- There are opportunities for peers to interact in class
- There are multi-sensory approaches to learning new concepts
- Instructions are presented visually
- Particular S&L methods suggested i.e., colourful semantics are adapted
- There are daily opportunities to label emotions and learn strategies
- Strategies are adapted and explained to parents to use at home
