Referring a NEW student with a Visual Impairment to SEaTSS for support?

Moving forward, if you wish to refer a student with a visual impairment, you need to ensure that a Medical Permission form is completed, in addition to a SEaTSS referral.

SEaTSS/ Joseph Clark are unable to begin support, until they have access to medical information. To speed up the process, please ensure this this completed at time of referrals

Manual Handling Training

A 2-day course training staff who will need to handle/ lift students from wheelchairs/ hoists etc.

Positive Handling Training

A 2-day course, looking at ways to defuse situations and safe ways of holding and moving a student who needs 'hands on' safe handling/ de-escalation.

SENCO Drop in sessions


