

## What can you do on an ipad?

ipads are a fantastic resource to use with SEN students. They provide instant differentiation, visual support and ways to engage the most challenging student. Listed below are skills Teachers /LSA's should have to enable them to make the most of the ipad. Skills I can do	Yes	No
I can use the sleep/wake mode.		
I can turn the iPad to change orientation from portrait to landscape.		
I can double click home button / use four fingers to swipe up to open multitasking bar.		
I can adjust the volume using the lever on the side of the iPad.		
I can also adjust the volume by using the multitasking bar.		
I can attach headphones to the iPad.		
I can use the multitasking bar to lock rotation.		
I can adjust brightness by using the multitasking bar.		
I can find installed apps using the search bar.		
I can use the home button to return to the Home Screen.		
I can swipe through the home screens.		
I can tap twice to zoom in and zoom out.		
I can also use two fingers (pinch & spread) to zoom in and zoom out.		
I can open the multitasking bar to display recently used apps and swap quickly between them.		
I can close the apps I recently used by opening the multitasking bar and sweeping upwards.		

I can use one finger to swipe to the right on my Home Screen to search the iPad.		
I can select text.		
I can copy and paste text.		
I can use the camera to take photos and record videos.		
I can find photos and videos taken.		
I can delete photos and videos.		
I can take a screenshot.		
I can use five fingers to pinch to the Home Screen.		
I can use four fingers to swipe left or right between apps and to open the multitasking bar.		
I can use content specific apps to increase students' reading, math, science, social studies, research fluency, and communication skills.		
I can use 'Guided Access'		
I know how to use 'Restrictions'.		
I can turn off adverts/ pop up's		
I can search for apps already purchased.		
I can delete an app.		
I can research and download free apps.		
I can purchase and download new apps.		
I can update apps.		
I can rearrange icons on home screen.		
I know what to do if icons start quivering on the screen.		
I can make and name a folder, and put apps into folders.		
I can hide apps.		
I know what to do if the iPad freezes.		
I know how to turn the iPad off completely.		
I can edit images, e.g. crop, enhance		
I can print off work / photos		

I can connect a Bluetooth keyboard/device		
I can use Safari to research for information and images.		
I can save images to the camera roll.		
I can edit pictures, e.g. crop, enhance.		
I can close open internet pages.		
I can bookmark pages on Internet.		
I can update the operating system (iOS) on my ipad.		
I can check how much memory has been used.
